The interesting fact is that less than half of the 102 people on the Mayflower were "Pilgrims" separatist protestants called 'Saints' at the time, the others half were called 'Strangers' and were just hitching a ride to the new world. They collectively signed an agreement before they landed to ensure representative self-government, by which all of them would be bound regardless of religious belief. The Mayflower Compact was the first written framework of majority governance in America.
